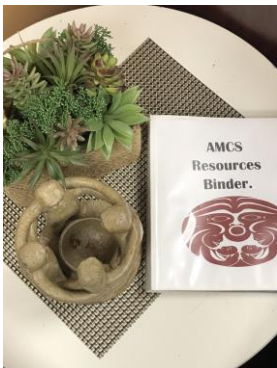

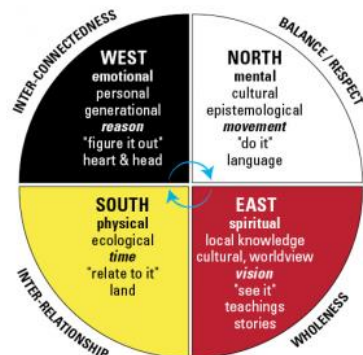

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## How do we help?

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- ❖ **Call** Sarah Thomas to make an appointment at 604 558-2627  
E: 7028
  - ❖ Intake Appointment:
    - please bring **2 pieces of ID** one picture and birth certificate,
    - current **3 month bank statements**,
    - **eviction notice** and rental tenancy agreement,
    - **proof of income**.
  - Once Intake is done and approved you will be assigned a worker.
  - ❖ **Keep in touch** with your worker.
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## What makes me Eligible?

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### To be eligible client must:

- ❖ First Nations or self identified as
- ❖ Currently experiencing homelessness
- ❖ Need help obtaining or sustaining housing, including shared housing

### Services Provided:

- ❖ Essential services in finding the resources to give support where needed.
  - ❖ Landlord liaison and intervention to prevent eviction and preserve tenancy
  - ❖ Emergency assistance to help avert eviction (for example food, clothing etc.)
  - ❖ Aboriginal Mother Centre- is the name of the organization, however we provide support to clients in all walks of life.
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
